You can be part of this change while empowering others in this process. The Education for Peace program can assist you to develop both spiritually and intellectually and acquire the necessary knowledge and skills to lead the change.

## WHAT IS IT?

The Education for Peace Program (EPP) is designed based the teachings of the Bahá'í Faith for junior youth aged 13-15. Beginning with an 8 day residential school at Yerrinbool Bahá'í Centre of Learning campus, students complete 12 distance learning assignments over the first year. The second residential school introduces new subjects with 12 new assignments.



## RESIDENTIAL SCHOOL?

Each of the 8 days of residential school begins with prayers and virtues pick, classes, sports, followed by afternoon activities of art appreciation, skills workshops, spiritual development and dinner. Every evening provides community time with games, quizzes, and socializing. Faculty and youth Assistant Faculty are dorm parents, leaders, and mentors during the residential school.

## STUDY?

Students submit 1 assignment per month. The assignments are quite varied and include time lines, short films, poetry, and interviews. While the assignments provide quality learning, they encourage creativity and are fun to complete.



## FEES?

A fee of \$450 per year is charged for the program which covers all the course materials including study guides, textbooks, plus the cost of administration, accommodation and meals during residential school.

## SCHOLARSHIPS?

Education for Peace Institute provides full or part scholarships to those students who cannot afford the fees. Please apply in writing by 15 October 2009 and justify your request.

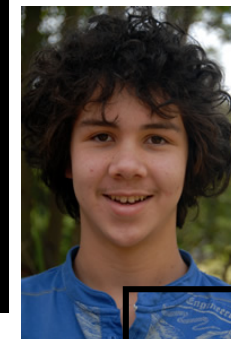
